Dr. Weil called the meeting of the Georgia Composite Medical Board to order at 8:00 a.m.

**AGENDA**

Dr. Antalis submitted a motion, seconded by Dr. Deloach, to approve the agenda of the December 5-6, 2013 meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

Dr. White submitted a motion, seconded by Dr. Chandler, to approve the minutes of the November 7-8, 2013 meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

**EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

LaSharn Hughes, Executive Director, presented the following information for the Board's review:

1. The Board discussed the Board's "Office Based Surgery Guidelines," and asked Ms. Hughes to move the guidelines to the home page of the Board's website and to send them interested parties on its mailing list.
2. Dr. Salvat asked that his public consent orders be removed from the Board's website, since he has met the terms and conditions of the order. The Board responded that state law required public orders to be posted.
3. The Georgia Board of Pharmacy asked the Board to send out information regarding prescription medications containing acetaminophen.
4. The Board accepted as information a letter from Dr. Koblar regarding the reinstatement fees.
5. Ms. Hughes informed the Board that a report recently released by the Department of Audits found that the Board is in compliance with the Budgetary Compliance Act.
6. Charles Gregory inquired whether a practice that performs office-based surgery would meet the Board's guideline requiring a proven accessible route to transfer a patient on stretcher to a hospital in the event of emergency. The practice would be located on the second floor of a building without an elevator. Based on the information provided, the Board found that the arrangement would not meet the guidelines.

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7. The Board reviewed a letter from Toni Hawkins requesting information regarding office-based surgery guidelines, and asked the staff to send Ms. Hawkins a copy of the guidelines.

2. Posted proposed Rule 360-8 for public comment.

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3. Dr. Gross submitted a motion, seconded by Dr. DeLoach, to post Proposed Amended Rule 360-10-.01, "Institutional Licenses," for public comment once the Attorney General's office has reviewed it. The motion carried unanimously.
4. Other Business: Marcus Downs, representing the Medical Association of Georgia, discussed the Healthcare Practitioner Transparency Act, which would require all medical office and hospital personnel to wear name tags clearly identifying their professions.
