EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

LaSharn Hughes, Executive Director, presented the following to the Board:

5. Reviewed options for Board Retreat. Executive Director advised there are no funds for a Board retreat.

8. Reviewed Dr. Kamath's version of the history of Georgia Medical Board. Dr. Summers suggested the staff check with the Georgia Historical Society for pictures.

Regarding a question from Cal Jones concerning who needs to supervise a radiology practitioner assistant when performing radiology procedures such as fluoroscopy and minor IR studies in a hospital setting – does it require on site supervision or is remote supervision via video or teleradiology allowed? Board suggested he consider going to the General Assembly to get legislation.
10. Lynn Burgoyne seeking guidelines relating to a physician's office using conscious sedation. Board is working on this matter.
11. Paul Breitenbecher emailed the questions:
 1. Does pathologist need a license?

13. Kevin Byre, M.D., MPH, requested advice as to where he can mail a device for sleep apnea and the patient send back to him for a report. He is licensed in California. Board advised he must be licensed in Georgia when mailing to Georgia patients.

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14. Maynard Merle – Emailed her concerns regarding requiring physicians to explain the side effects of medicines. Board advised this falls under Pharmacy law. They are required to counsel patients on medications.
15. The Georgia Board of Nursing asked if RN's and LPN's can dictate, transcribe or document certain entries in a medical record. Board advised they can not do this in place of physician notes. Physicians can delegate this to a RN.

Gunn, Jr., M.D. – Requested a letter from the Board stating that medical doctors can administer and/or supervise the administration of medical treatments such as ultrasound, active wound care, measurement, unattended electrical stimulation, vital signs, hot and cold packs, massage, vibratory massage, application of analgesic balm, effleurage, tapotement, traction, trigger point massage and therapeutic exercises and other modalities at the physicians discretion. Although a physician can do the procedures he may not delegate all of this to an unlicensed person.
